Scott will be closing out the Golden Gate Section's 2017-2018 technical program year as he discusses the advantages an individual with an NDT background has when insuring suppliers deliver high quality products to the end user.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH:

*Scott Morris:* After graduating with an A.A.S. Degree in Nondestructive Testing from Ridgewater College in Hutchinson, MN in the mid 1990's, Scott Morris has remained actively involved as an NDT practitioner in the power generation, oil and gas, aerospace, and manufacturing industry sectors. During Scott's near twenty-five years of involvement in the NDT community, he has achieved ASNT Level III certifications in the radiography, liquid penetrant, visual, magnetic particle, and ultrasonic testing methods. In his current role as a Supplier Quality Source Inspection Engineer, Expert with the Pacific Gas & Electric Corporation in San Francisco, CA, Scott is responsible for final product audits at domestic and international supplier locations. Products and materials risk ranked as critical will receive a thorough inspection prior to being utilized in PG&E's gas, electric, and power generation lines of business. Gaining additional certifications as an API 570 pipeline inspector, API 580 risk-based inspector, API 1169 pipeline construction inspector, NACE Level II coating inspector, AWS CWI, as well as American Society of Quality inspector and quality auditor certifications has provided the validation of the necessary skill level required to engage with internal and external stakeholders during the new material procurement process.
